





My mother wrote you a letter as follows:


## Dear Frederic.

These days like a dream to me! I never imagine that one day I can read the very writings of my beloved daughter, can know her life in the fierce situation of the battle! And these writings has been respectfully carrying for 35 years by a man who was at the opposite side! Oh, it must be a man with kindfull, must be a man with honorable heart that can have those actions, that can think of the diary's author like your thinkings. Only a man like that can carry it and try to return it to her miserable mother and her family. Like many chidrel - lost mother on the world, right now the pain and tears make me inable describe my heart to you. For the pain always can't be described in words, now I can't say nothing else other than tell you the unlimited gratefull to you - whom from now on I would like to regard as one member of our family. About the case of sacrified of my daughter, her friend told me that the location is in deep jungle on west mountain of Duc Pho. She lay only 50 m far from the clinic, there were also 2 other men killed in that battle but at the other site of the jungle. In our country, there were so many pains and losses in the war that people can confuse details.



















